**Eligibility and Award**

One or more scholarships of at least \$500 but not more than \$1000 will be awarded. Qualifying student(s) must have completed two years or more of a post-graduate Veterinary program of an accredited University or Veterinary School. The scholarship is available to a New Jersey student attending the Veterinary School.

The deadline for applications is September 1st this year. As the scholarship will be available every year until cancelled, you may retain a copy of the application for your files. All correspondence should be addressed to the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee at the above address.

Process for Selecting a Winner

The Scholarship Committee will meet after October 1<sup>st</sup> to determine the winner(s).

1. The Committee will accept only fully completed applications. This includes:
  - a) Application form fully completed
  - b) Two letters of reference
  - c) Proof of residency in New Jersey
2. The Committee will judge the applicant based upon the following categories:
  - a) Financial need
  - b) Academic excellence
  - c) Career goals
  - d) Recommendations
3. The Committee will arrive at the consensus winner(s) and a check will then be sent to the College or University for the benefit of the winner(s).
